Sub. Engg – VUDA – Construction of Sports Complex in Junior College Ground at Tuni – Proposals submitted for approval - Draft subject placed before VUDA Board for perusal & approval – Reg.

Agenda Note:

Government vide G O Ms No 525, Dt-30-07-2006, have issued for extension of jurisdiction covering in 4 Districts – Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam and East Godavari consisting 3 Municipalities i.e. Amadalavalasa, Srikakulam, Tuni and Rajam Nagara Panchayat. Thereby jurisdiction of VUDA extended to 5573 Sq KM.

In accordance with the mandate of VUDA and with a view to provide infrastructure facilities in extended limits also, Vice Chairman, VUDA conducted Review Meeting with all Commissioners of respective Municipalities and instructed to send proposals for development of Master Plan Roads / Major connecting Roads and any other important development activity beneficial to general public in Municipal limits.

In accordance with the above Commissioner, Tuni Municipality has requested VUDA to take up the construction of Sports Complex in the vacant site available at Junior College in Tuni Town as there is no such facility in Tuni town so far.

Based on the request of Commissioner, Tuni Municipality and as per the instructions of Vice Chairman, VUDA a line estimate has been prepared for construction of Sports Complex comprising of both indoor and outdoor stadiums including amenities required on the similar lines of Rajiv sports complex constructed by VUDA at Vizianagaram for Rs 5.00 Crores.

The following are the salient features of Sports Complex proposed.

- Compound wall, Parking facility, Security cabin, Water supply and Sanitary arrangements, Electrification to Indoor and Outdoor stadium are also included

Further it will be a landmark to Tuni and by taking this project credibility of VUDA will be increased considerably in extended limits also.

Hence, the matter is placed before VUDA Board for perusal and approval.
